Conditions of Participation:

All submissions must meet the conditions set forth in the **Rules** provided.

Submissions must **be created by registered Nunavut Inuit** and:

- Be at least 1 minute and not more than 3 minutes in length (including all credits)
- Be in Inuktitut or English
- Be suitable for publication in a public forum. This means the submission must not:
 - Contain material that violates or infringes upon the rights of third parties, including, privacy, publicity, copyright and other intellectual property rights;
 - Contain branded products, company names or trademarks;
 - Contain material that promotes bigotry, racism, hatred or harm, against any group or individual or promotes discrimination based on race, gender, religion, nationality, disability sexual orientation or age.
- Be the entrant's original work and must be created specifically for NFDC's short video challenge.

The following conditions must also be agreed to:

The ownership of the intellectual property in the submission and any work created from the materials contained in the submission will remain with the applicant. The entrant grants Nunavut FIT a royalty-free, perpetual, non-exclusive world-wide license to use (where such use includes but not limited to reproduction and performance rights) the submission and any work derived therefrom, including any completed film in any media and for any purpose whatsoever, the whole without additional compensation. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, Nunavut FIT will be allowed full usage of the submission and any work derived therefrom, including any completed film for promotional purposes, including commercial advertisements, public and press screenings, corporate and promotional websites and print material, without further compensation.

Evaluation Criteria:

All video submissions will be evaluated by a committee of industry professionals selected by Nunavut FIT (the “Industry Advisory Committee” or ‘jury ‘) based on the evaluation criteria set out below and whose decisions are final, binding and not subject to review.

The Industry Advisory Committee will independently review the videos and assign a numerical value to each submission on a scale of 1 to 5 (5 being the highest score), based on the following criteria:

1. The participant’s video takes full advantage of, and is conducive to the short form.
2. The participant’s video is engaging.
3. Overall enjoyment of the video by the jury.

The jury’s top selection will be announced on or before April 24th ,2020.

All chosen videos will receive \$100.00.
